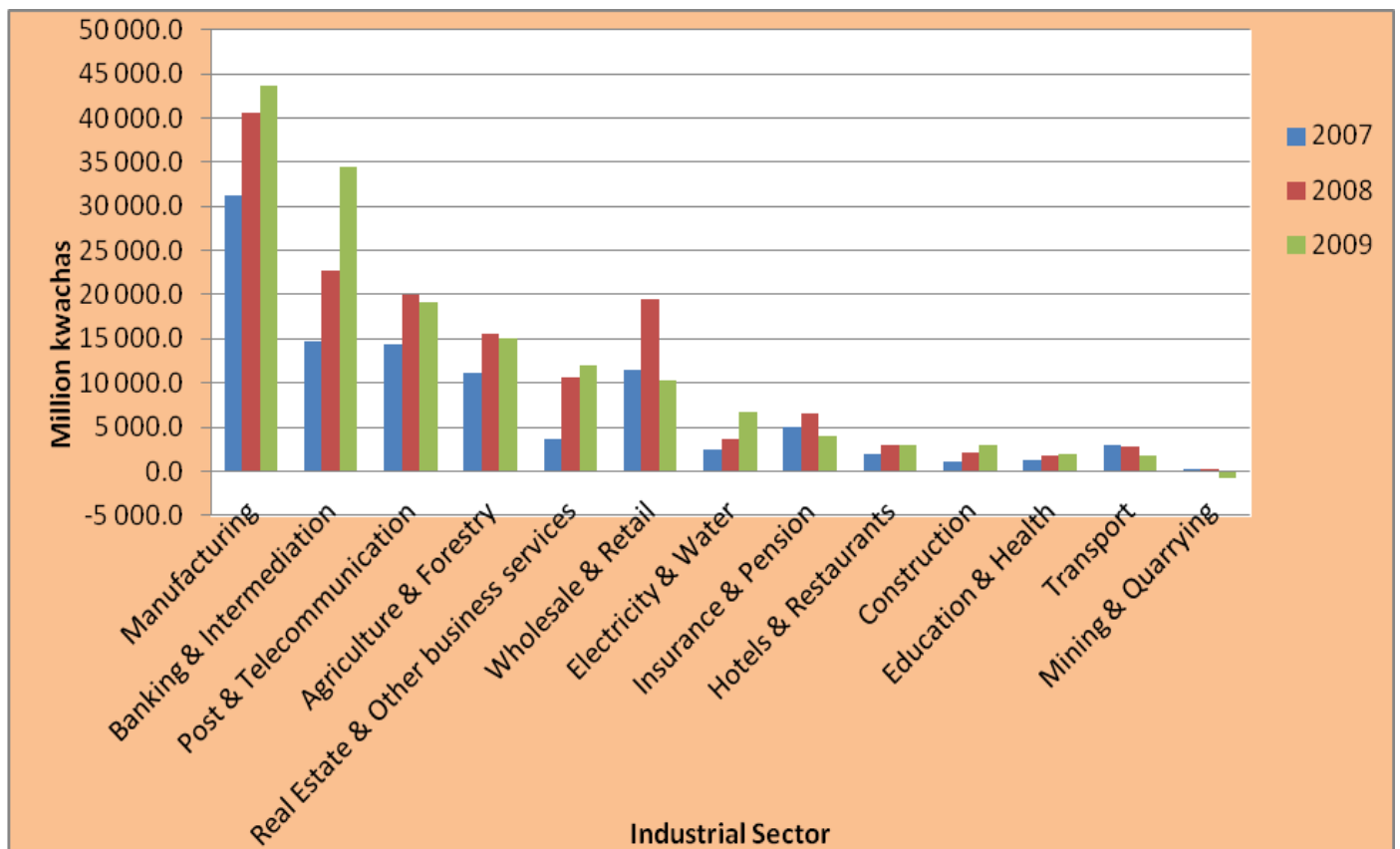

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PREFACE

Annual Economic Survey (AES) reports provide detailed information on the economic activities of large-scale profit making enterprises in the country. The indicators compiled from this survey include employment, turnover, stocks, value added and gross profit by sector. A sector is an aggregation of various enterprises that have been grouped according to the United Nations International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC). The estimates are of importance to the country's calculation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) through Supply and Use tables.

Reported in current Kwacha values, the survey brings to light that over the period 2007-2009 there has been increases in total income, remuneration, total purchases, value added, employment and gross profit.

This work has been successful because of the co-operation of various business enterprises, statutory bodies and government departments, which supplied the information. Their co-operation in this exercise is greatly appreciated.

I would like to acknowledge the financial support provided by the Norwegian Government and technical advice from Statistics Norway. The Industrial Statistics Section and the rest of the Economics Statistics Division of the NSO should also be commended for their excellent work in coming up with this report.

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CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

This report is the thirteenth in the Annual Economic Survey (AES) series and gives results from the survey for 2007 to 2009. The survey aims at covering all large-scale profit enterprises in Malawi. Estimates are given at current prices in the report. The sample has partly been updated to reflect the deaths and births of major enterprises in the economy over time.

Although the AES mainly covers the large scale enterprises, due to the current importance of medium and small-scale enterprises, the survey has begun to progressively incorporate these companies in order to monitor the substantive growth of the entire economy.

1.2 Rationale, Aim and Survey Coverage

The rationale of the survey is to give a quantitative description of the activities of mainly large-scale enterprises in all sectors of the Malawian economy with respect to their production, employment characteristics, profitability, acquisition and issue of both real and financial claims in different sectors of the economy.

The aim of the survey is to come up with total value added, profitability and formation of fixed assets in the 15 sectors of the large scale and some medium scale sectors.

The main criterion used to include an enterprise is employment and overall annual turnover level within the sector. In some sectors, all enterprises have been included if the sector has too few enterprises. Where an enterprise did not respond because it has ceased operating, a replacement was done. The AES covers private, statutory bodies and public (government) sectors engaged in the production and sale of goods and services on the market at prices normally designed to cover the cost of production.

CHAPTER 2

SURVEY METHODOLOGY

2.1 Selection of Enterprises

The enterprises selected for the survey were obtained from the Business Information Register (BIR). The BIR has routinely updated information on large and medium scaled businesses in the years from 2007 to 2009. It is a database containing information on enterprises known by the National Statistical Office to be operational in Malawi. The register includes the population of large scale enterprises fairly well, but for the population of medium sized enterprises the coverage is not currently exhaustive. The BIR gives information on both enterprises and the underlying establishments. This database contains names, addresses, type of activity, number of employees and turnover.

A total number of about 440 enterprises were given questionnaires to complete. Out of which 438 in 2007; 437 in 2008 and 430 in 2009 either responded or there was data for one of the years to enable us estimate for the missing year.

2.2 Data Collection

The AES is conducted annually through mail questionnaires sent to all large scale profit oriented enterprises. The reference period for the information collected is twelve months which is an enterprise's financial year. However, the end date of the financial year varies between enterprises. The survey determines which calendar year an enterprise should be included. For example, any enterprise with its financial year ending 31st March will be considered to have operated in the previous year because the current year has only three months as compared to nine months in the previous year.

Currently, data is collected through personal delivery of questionnaires to respective respondents from the enterprises. Interviewers were sent to deliver and collect completed questionnaires.

Three teams comprising a supervisor, 4 interviewers and a driver in each team were formed. One team was responsible for central and northern region. Two teams concentrated in the southern and eastern regions. The eastern region team visited enterprises in Limbe, Thyolo, Mulanje, Zomba, Machinga, Mangochi and Balaka districts. The southern region team worked in Blantyre main and Chikwawa district.

The teams visited the enterprises three times. The first exercise was to deliver the questionnaires for the respondents to complete within a month. Thereafter, the teams went for questionnaire collection. After noting that the response rate was very low two more follow-ups were conducted to enhance the response rate. There was an improvement in the number of questionnaires collected on the third trip.

Due to the diversity in the nature of businesses in the different sectors, the AES uses activity-specific questionnaires.

The AES questionnaires have had minor adjustments over the recent years. Separate questionnaires were used for each of the following 11 sector groups: Agriculture, Manufacturing and Mining, Electricity and Water, Construction, Wholesale and Retail, Hotels and Restaurants, Post and Telecommunications, Transport Banking, Insurance, and Other service industries. The enterprises were handed questionnaires tailored for their activities. Enterprises were requested to respond to the survey questions, basically as reflected in their annual statements of accounts. A sample copy of the questionnaire for the Manufacturing sector is included in Appendix 1.

2.3 Data Processing

On receipt of the questionnaires, they were checked for errors and discrepancies. The questionnaires were checked for internal inconsistencies, but also if changes from responses in the previous survey were reasonable. Where company accounts were available, crosschecks were also made with the questionnaires to detect omissions and inconsistencies. Errors and discrepancies found were corrected after consultation with the respondent.

For enterprises that failed to respond (unit non-response) and enterprises with incomplete answers (item non-response) the missing information were estimated. In cases where current annual company accounts were available, their questionnaires were completed at the office using these accounts as a basis for estimation. In other cases, missing data were imputed by applying the same growth rate generated by the enterprises that responded in both years (2007-2009). Separate growth rates were calculated and used for total sales, total purchases, employment and remuneration per employee. There were two types of checks, manual check and computer validation.

Data entry was done through scanning of the questionnaires. The data was thereafter exported to SPSS for further cleaning while tabulation and further analysis were done in excel.

2.4 Presentation of Results

The United Nations International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) Rev.4 is used to classify economic activities in this report. Where possible, the tables are presented at the 4-digit ISIC level. However, some activities are combined in order to ensure confidentiality in line with the 1967 Statistics Act. This stipulates that no presentation will be made, which could expose the information of the activities of an individual or a single business undertaking. The standard procedure is to publish aggregated data for at least three enterprises.

To this effect the report has activities classified at 2-digit, 3-digit and 4-digit levels. For further information on the adopted ISIC groups, refer to Appendix 2.

The layout of the report is as follows: - there is a section that gives a brief discussion on selected indicators entitled Survey Findings. Following the discussion there are statistical tables, which may be used for extended sector-specific analysis.

2.5 Concepts and Definitions

- (a) *Sales of Goods (SG)*: Capitalised work done by own employees plus total sales of goods and services produced by firms. Capitalised work done is charged to the capital account.

- (b) *Sales of Goods bought for Resale (SGR)*: Total sales of goods resold without further processing.

- (c) *Total Income (TI)*: All incomes of an enterprise; from sales of commodities, income from contracts, income from repairs & maintenance, agency commissions, services or interest.

- (d) *Stocks*: Total stocks including finished products, materials and supplies, goods for resale, work in progress and goods in transit.

- (e) *Purchases of Materials and Supplies used in Production (PMSP)*: All materials and supplies purchased, which are used directly in the production of goods and rendering of services. General

administration expenditures and services that do not vary with the quantity of goods produced or services rendered are classified as indirect services and is excluded here (see under (g)).

(f) *Purchases of Goods for Resale (PGR)*: All goods, which are purchased and resold without further processing including delivery costs.

(g) *Indirect services (IS)*: Expenditure that is unrelated to the volume of goods produced and services rendered. It includes general and administrative costs, advertising, insurance premiums, and payments for utilities, stationery and rent expenditure.

(h) *Remuneration*: Total wages and salaries paid to employees. This includes all payments in cash or in kind during the reference year in relation to work done for the enterprise i.e. gratuities, bonus, overtime, benefits in cash and kind and pension contributions.

(i) *Depreciation*: Total allowance for depreciation declared in the company accounts. These figures are based on the historic cost. Fully depreciated assets may still be providing useful services and yet not reflected in the depreciation figure.

(j) *Gross profit (GP)*: Value added less remuneration. .

(k) *Net trading profit (NTP)*: Gross profit less depreciation.

(l) *Employment*: The total number of persons who worked in or for the enterprise during the reference year. The figures reported refer normally to the average number of employees including working proprietors, unpaid family workers and managerial staff.

(m) *Capital Investment in Fixed Assets (CIFA)*: Value of new fixed capital assets purchased less sales of fixed capital assets.

(n) *Value Added (Market Prices)*: Value added is the value of output (total incomes) less the value of inputs, which covers (a) value of materials supplied for production or service (including cost of all fuel and electricity) and (b) cost of industrial services received.

(o) *Net Stocks (NS)*: The difference between Stocks End of Year (SEoY) and Stocks Beginning of Year (SBoY) or (SEoY) less (SBoY).

CHAPTER 3

SURVEY FINDINGS

3.1 Introduction

This section presents the basic results on the performance of industries in their broad ISIC categories. This is with respect to employment, remuneration, total incomes, total purchases, value added, capital investment and gross profit for the report period 2007 to 2009. The graphs and figures included in the discussion are derived from Table 1. The section concludes with a summary highlighting the main findings. It has to be noted that in some tables, number of enterprises have either dropped or increased over the period. This is so because either there has been a change of activities within an enterprise or new enterprises have emerged or ceased operating.

3.2 Employment and Remuneration

From Table 1 employment for all the enterprises increased from 175 200 in 2007; 183 000 in 2008 to 205 000 in 2009. Figure 1 below, shows the number of employed persons for the large-scale enterprises included in the AES across industries.

Figure 1: Employment by Sector Group 2007 – 2009

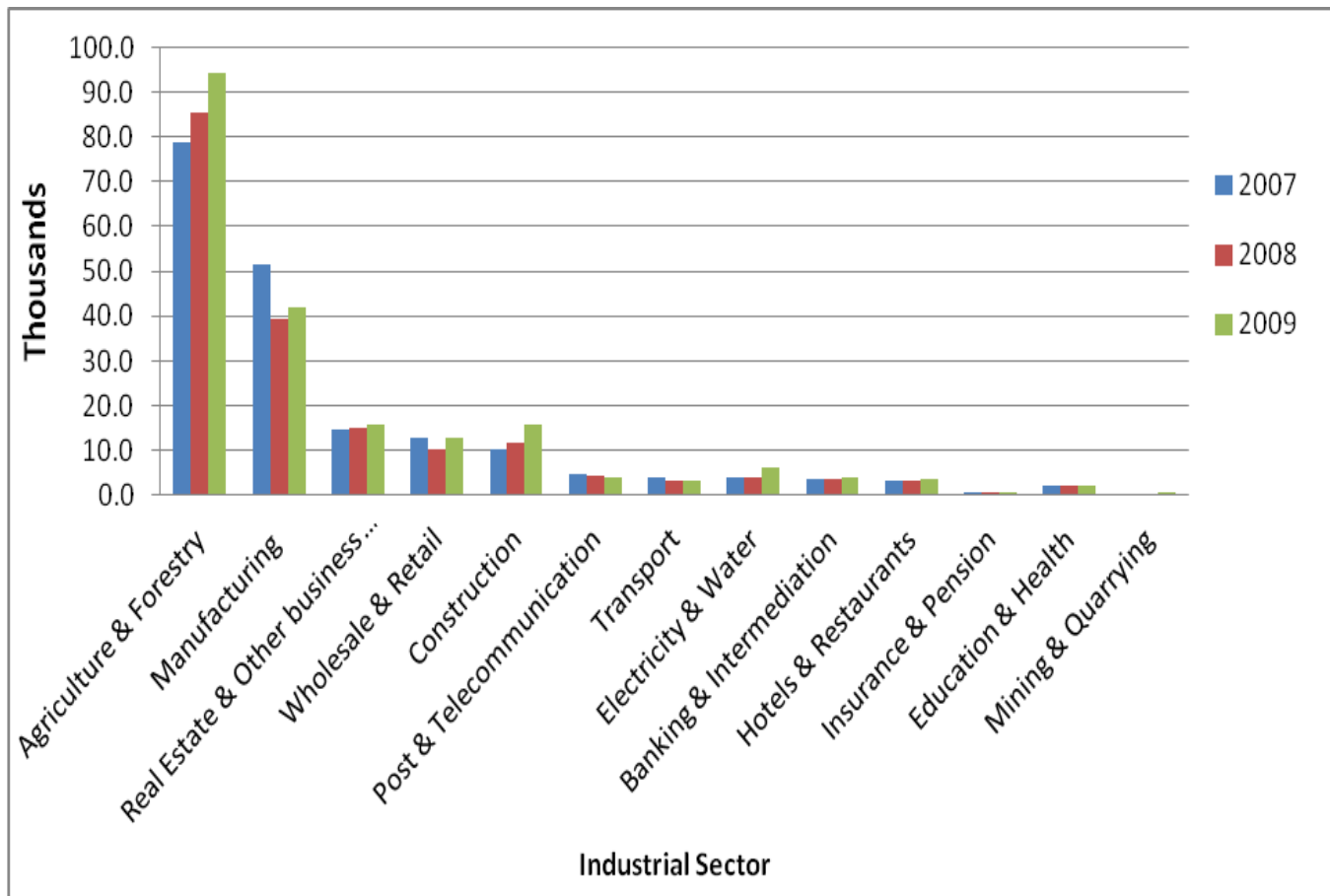


Figure 1 shows that between 2007 and 2009, employment in the Agriculture and Forestry sector increased from about 79,000 employees in 2007 to about 94,000 employees in 2009. The Manufacturing experienced a decrease from about 51,000 employees in 2007 to about 39,000 employees in 2008. However, there was an increase in employment in 2009 up to about 42,000 employees.

In the Real Estate and Other Business Activities, employment was stagnant between 2007 and 2008 with about 14,000 employees. The employment slightly went up to about 15,000 in 2009. The Insurance and pension sector employed less than 1,000 in all years under consideration. The Mining and Quarrying sector employment grew from about 470 in 2007 to about 700 in 2009. However, the remaining sectors show a constant employment between the three years, while others experienced a minor decline.

Figure 2: Total Remuneration by Sector Group, 2007 – 2009

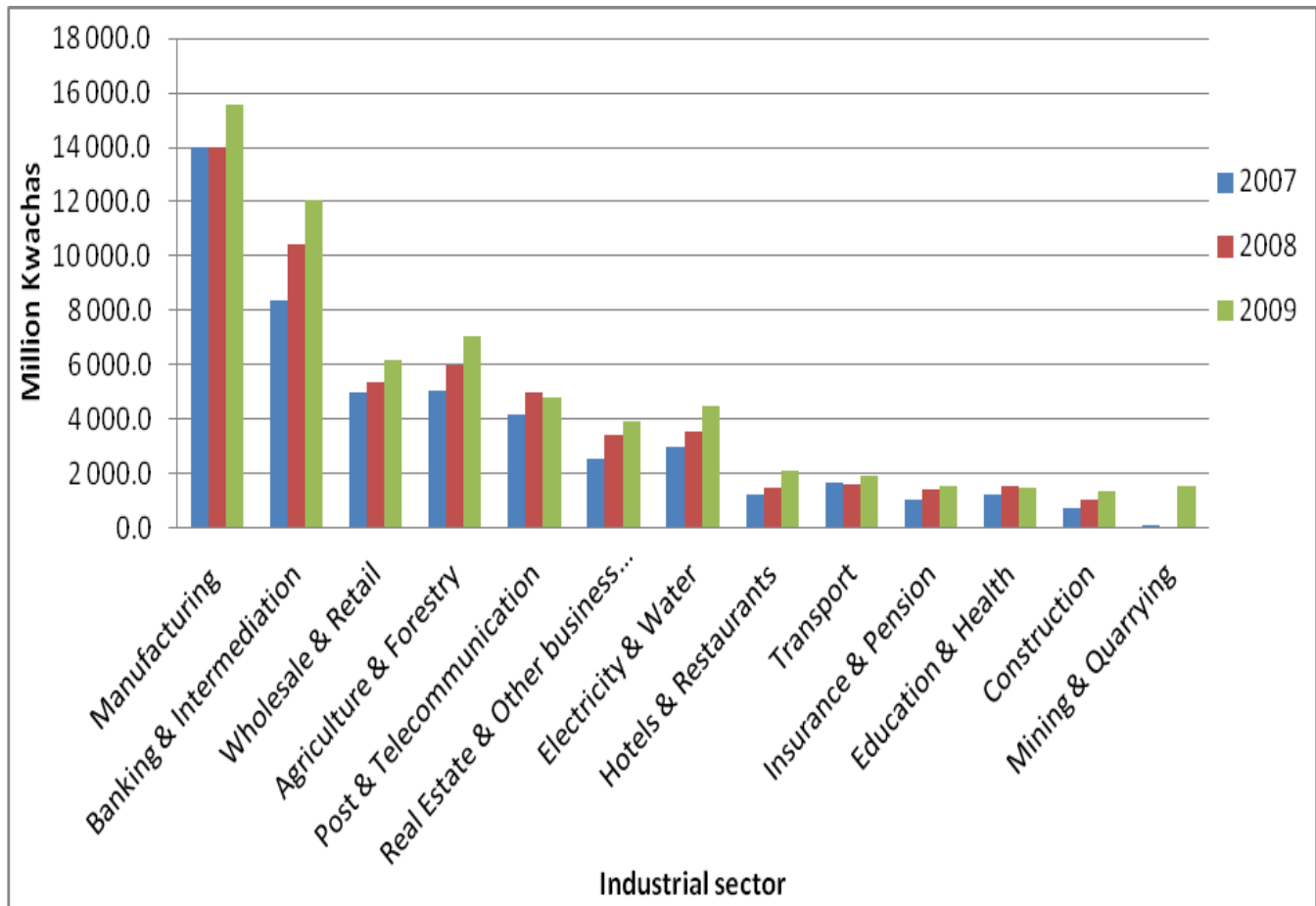


Figure 2 above depicts total remuneration by sector in 2007 to 2009. The Manufacturing Sector has the highest remuneration. Over the reporting period remuneration in the Manufacturing sector increased from about K14 billion in 2007 to about K15 billion in 2009. The Agriculture and Forestry sector increased in remuneration from K5 billion to K7 billion from 2007 to 2009. The Electricity and Water sector increased from about K3 billion to K4 billion in 2009. The Mining and quarrying remuneration increased from K 82million in 2007 to about K1.6 billion in 2009. The remaining sectors experienced minor increases.

Figure 3: Remuneration per Employee by Sector Group, 2007 – 2009

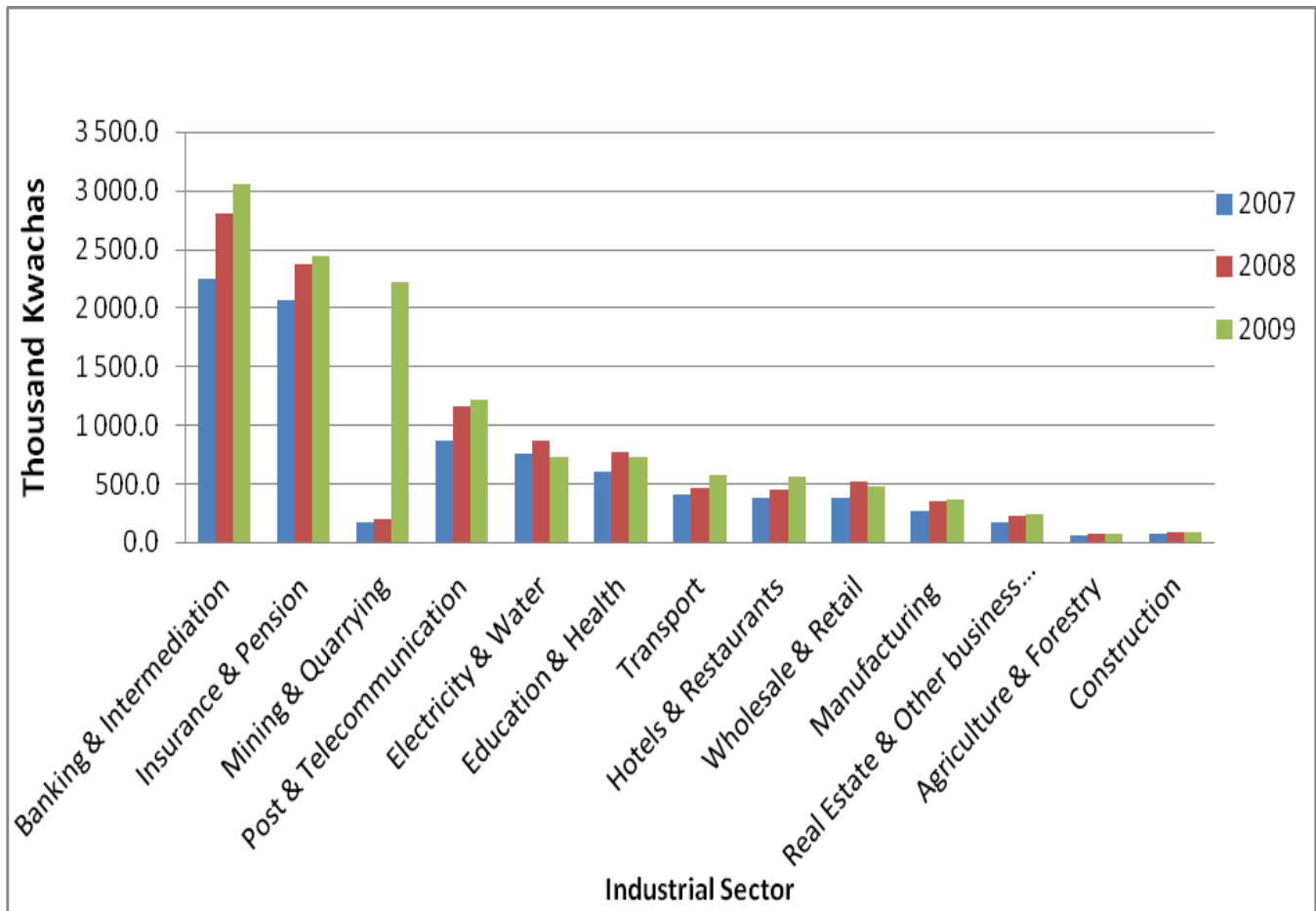


Figure 3 shows that the remuneration per employee for the Banking and Intermediation sector has grown from about K2.2 million in 2007 to about K3.1 million in 2009. The insurance and pensions has also grown from about K2 million to about K2.4 million. In Mining and Quarrying, remuneration per employee increased from K175 thousand in 2007 to about K2.2 million in 2009. There have been minimal growth rates in remuneration per employee in the Agriculture and Forestry sector and the Construction sector.

Figure 4: Income by Sector Group, 2007 – 2009

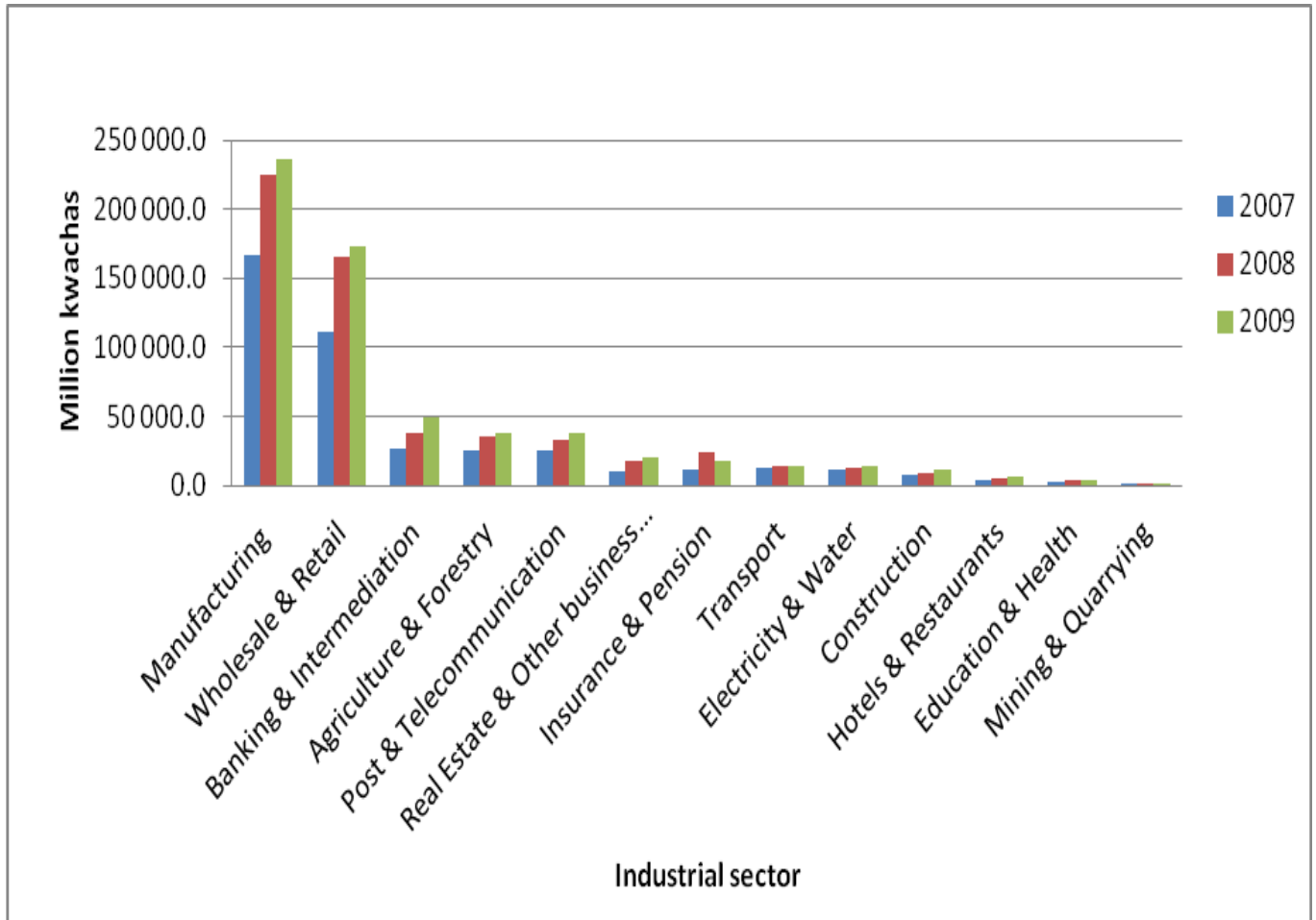


Figure 4 shows that the Manufacturing had an increase in income from about K167 billion in 2006, K225 billion in 2007 to K235 billion in 2009. The Wholesale and Retail sector increased its income from K111 billion in 2006, K165 billion in 2007 to about K172 billion in 2009. Overall, all sectors had an increase in total income.

Figure 5: Purchases by Sector Group, 2007 - 2009

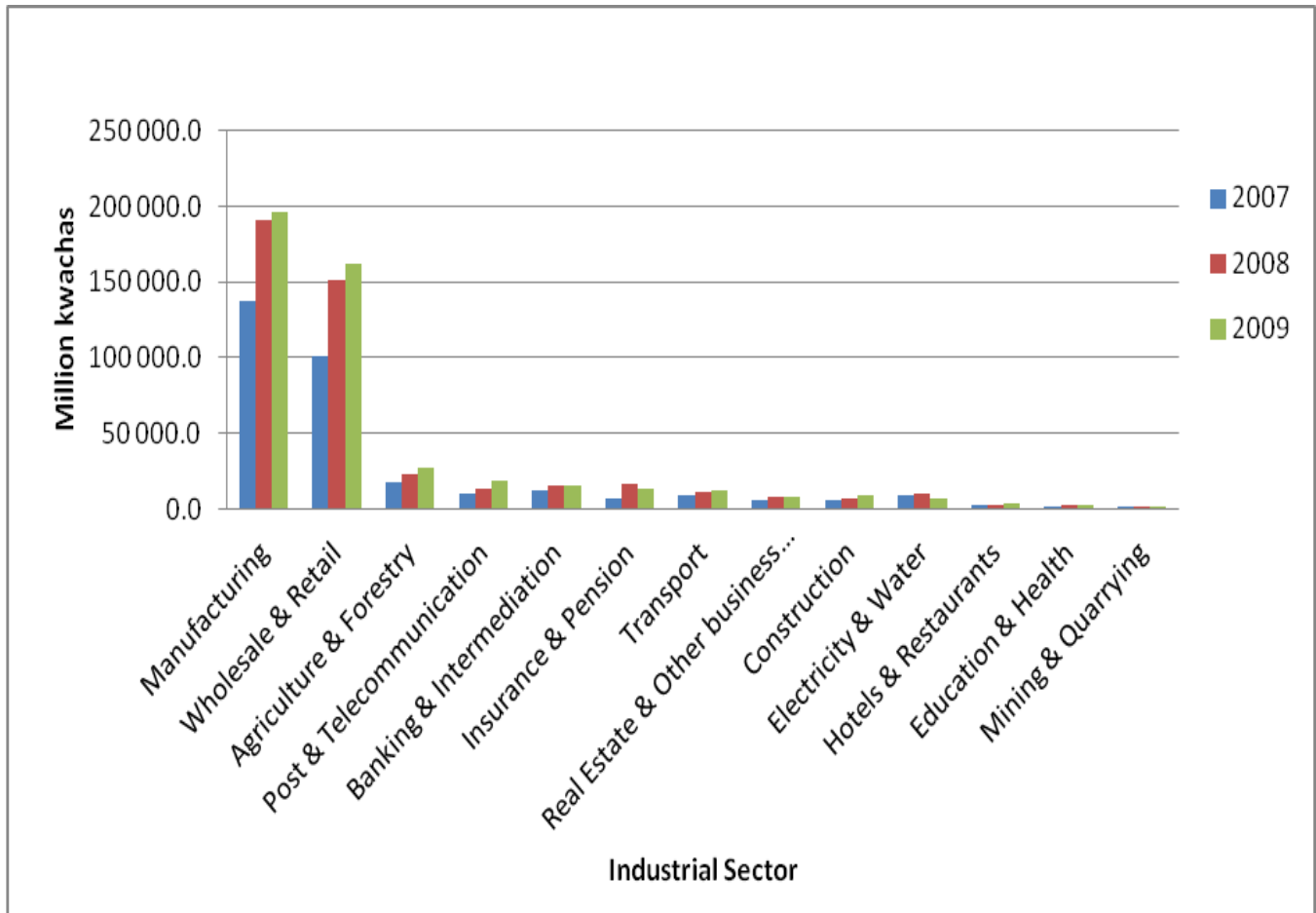
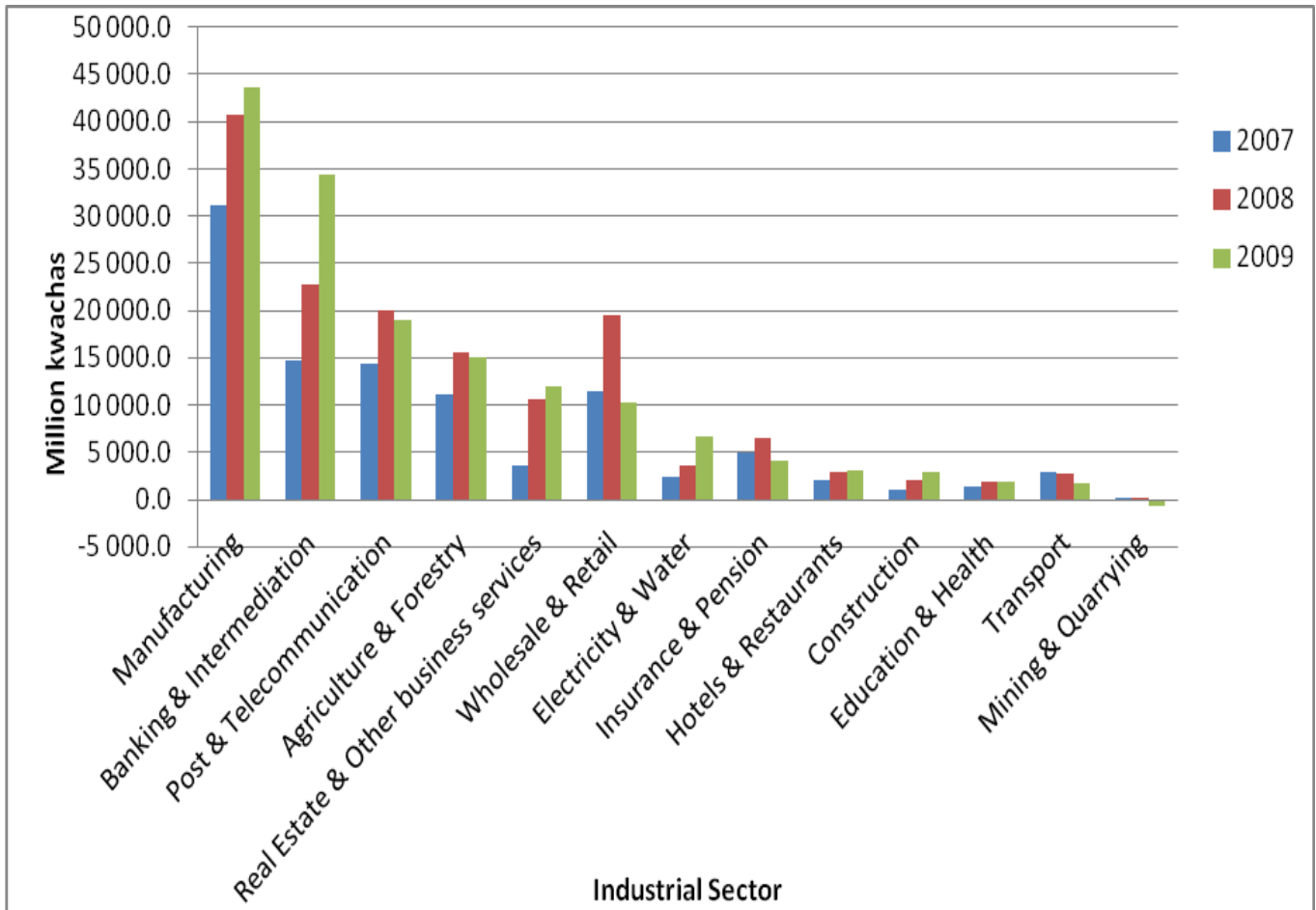


Figure 5 shows that overall the Manufacturing sector as well as the Wholesale and Retail registered the highest total purchases with the latter having total purchases of about K195 billion in 2009 from K190 billion spent in 2008. The Wholesale and Retail spent K161 billion in 2009 from K151 billion spent in 2008. The Agriculture and Forestry, Post and Telecommunications, the Transport sector and Construction registered increases in total purchases over the years.

Figure 6: Total Value Added by Sector Group, 2007 – 2009

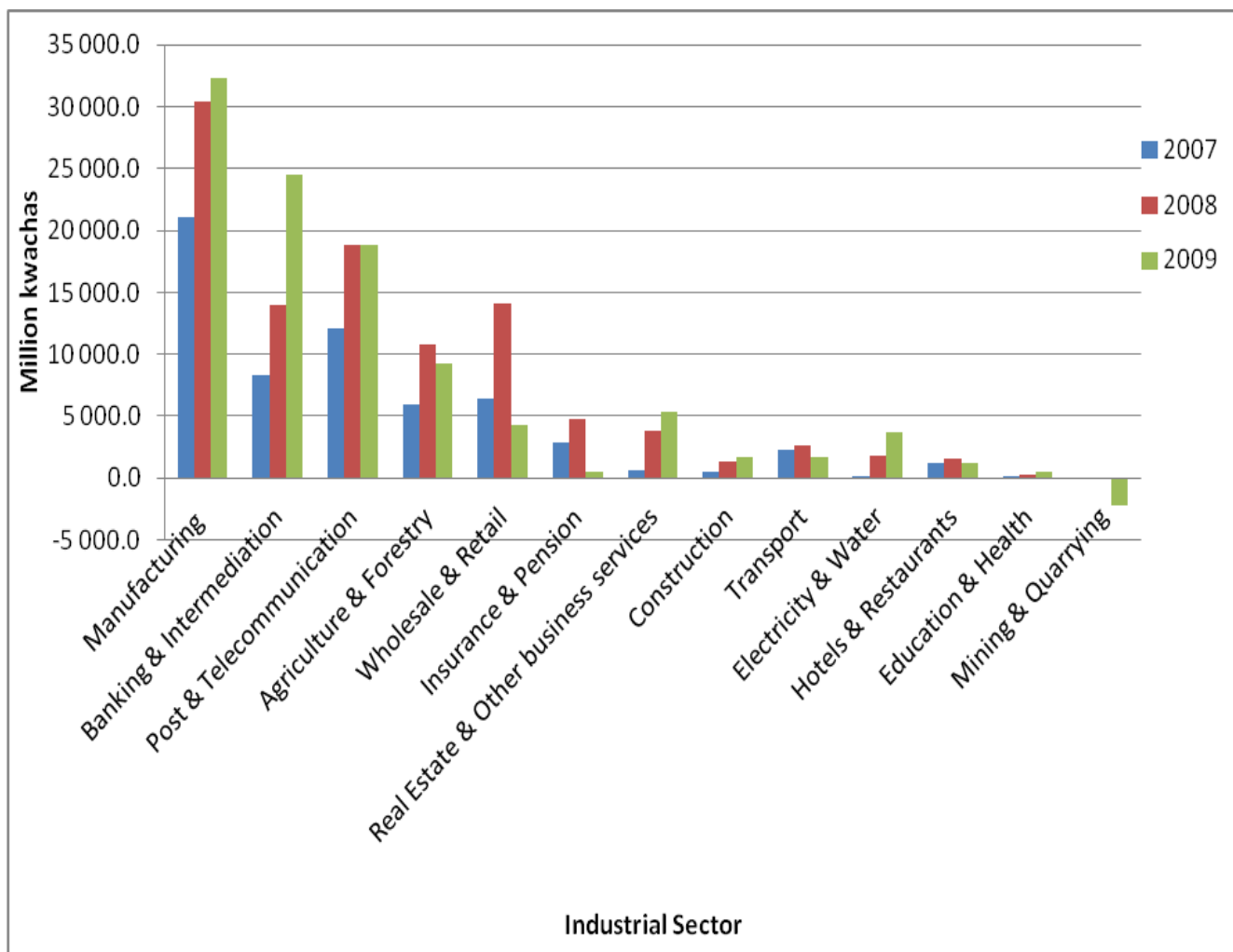


From Figure 6, in the Manufacturing sector, annual value added rose from about K31 billion in 2007, to K41 billion in 2008, to K43 billion in 2009. The Banking and Intermediation experienced a high growth in the value added over the two years, increasing from K14 billion in 2007 to K22 billion in 2008 to K34 billion in 2009. In the Transport sector, the value added decreased from K2.9 billion in 2007 to K2.8 billion in 2008 to K1.7 billion in 2009. There was a negative value added of K717 million in the Mining and quarrying sector in 2009. There was an increase in value added in Electricity and Water, Hotels and Restaurants and Construction over the years.

3.6 Gross Profit

Total Gross profit for the reporting period rose from K64 billion in 2007 to K115 billion in 2008 before decreasing to K113 billion in 2009. The Manufacturing sector increased from K21 billion in 2007 to K30.5 billion in 2008 and thereafter rising to about K32 billion in 2009. The Transport, Insurance and pension sectors registered a drop in gross profits from 2008 to 2009. The Wholesale and Retail sector registered a significant drop in gross profits from K6 billion in 2008 to about K4 billion in 2009. The net stock holding within the industry had gone down in between the period. The Insurance and pension registered a gross profit of about K470 million in 2009 from K4 billion gained in 2008 due to an increase in premium claims in the industry.

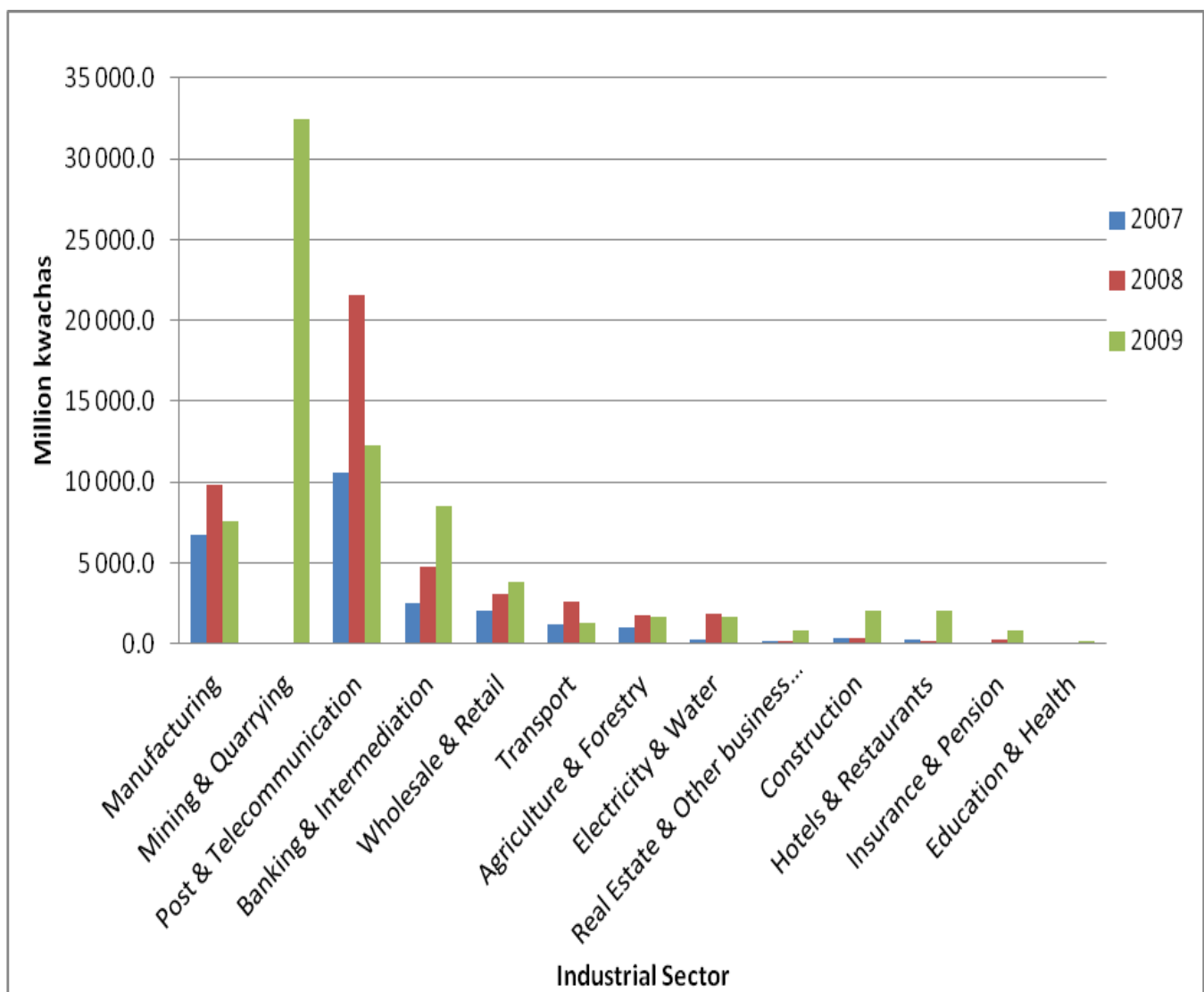
Figure 7: Gross Profit by Sector Group, 2007 – 2009



3.7 Capital Investments

The total Capital Investments for large scale enterprises changed from K25 billion for 2007; K46 billion in 2008 to K75 billion in 2009 Table 1. From Figure 8, the Manufacturing Sector went up from about K6.7 billion in 2007 to about K7 billion in 2009. The Mining and quarrying sector increased from K28 million in 2007 to about K42 billion in 2009. The Post and Telecommunication sector registered an increase in investments in 2008 from K10 billion in 2007 to about K21 billion in 2008 before the investment level decreased to K12 billion in 2009. In the same vein, Hotels and Restaurants witnessed an increase in investment levels from K169 million in 2008 to close to K2 billion in 2009.

3.8 Summary

The results of Annual Economic Survey for 2007 to 2009 gave a quantitative description of the economic activity of 438 large-scale enterprises in the Malawian economy.

In general, over the three year period surveyed, the results show that the activities of large-scale enterprises have increased. Table 1 shows that total income increased from K414 billion in 2007 to K620 billion in 2009 percent while total purchases increased from K319 billion in 2007 to K475 billion in 2009. The total value added increased from K100 billion in 2007 to K152 billion in 2009, while remuneration per employee rose by 20 percent between 2007 and 2009. Total employment increased from 175,000 in 2007 to 205,000 in 2009.
